

Harrison Park Campground Rules and Regulations



Campground Reservation

- The minimum age for a campground rental permit holder is 18.
- All campground reservations must be made online at <https://www.owensoundtourism.ca/en/explore-owen-sound/parksrecreation/camping-and-rv>.
- Full payment is required at the time of online booking using a credit card only (Visa, Mastercard).
- A \$20 administration fee is charged per requested change to an existing reservation.
- The maximum length of stay at a campground site is fourteen consecutive nights on one site.
- Please verify that your camper does not exceed the recommended size for the site you are reserving as described on the website.
- Debit is accepted at the campground registration booth during regular-season operating hours.
- Please note the campground booth is a cashless facility and only accepts debit cards for campground purchases.
- All campground reservation cancellations are subject to Policy CS-086. All cancellations must be completed online using the prescribed form.

Registration

Registration occurs at the campground registration booth at Harrison Park at 75 2nd Avenue East for both Harrison Park and Kelso Beach Campground reservations.

- All campers must arrive to register and obtain a campground rental permit no later than 8:00pm.
- Check-in time starts daily at 4:00pm; Check-out time ends at 11:00am.
- One (1) vehicle is allowed to be parked on each campground site. Licence plate information for the vehicle parked on each campground site will be registered against the campground rental permit.
- Campers may purchase parking passes for additional vehicles that can be parked at a separate designated parking lot.
- Maximum of two (2) adults & up to four (4) children or four (4) adults per campground site.
- Please note that the campground booth does not accept cash and all campground registration booth purchases will require a credit card (Visa, Mastercard) or debit card.

Visitors/Guests

- All visitors/guests of campground rental permit holder must register at the campground registration booth.
- Visitors/guests must leave the campground by 11:00pm.
- Visitor/guest vehicles must not park in campground. Alternate parking in the park is available and parking passes can be purchased by visitors/guests at the campground registration booth for a designated parking lot for campground rental permit holders and their visitors/guests.

Alcoholic Beverages

- Confined to campground sites only.

Pets

- Pets welcome and must be kept on a leash at all times.
- Don't leave your pet unattended in a vehicle, on your campsite, or anywhere else during your visit.
- Be a responsible pet owner and remember to "stoop and scoop" to clean up after your pet.

Quiet Time

- 11:00pm to 8:00am.
- Excessive noise or abusive language will not be tolerated any time. Courtesy and consideration for all campers must be exercised.

Campground Regulations

- Please place garbage and recyclable items in the containers provided.
- Campfires must be inside the rings provided. There is a limit of one (1) campfire ring per site.
- There is a limit of one (1) picnic table per site.
- Please do not place a grill on a picnic table when hot or while being used to cook.
- Please supervise your children at all times.
- Absolutely **NO** outside firewood is permitted to be brought to the campground - firewood is supplied for a nominal fee and is available at the campground registration booth.
- Obey all signs in the campground and observe the posted speed limit.
- Vehicles must remain on hardened surfaces, paved and gravel roads.
- The use of ATVs, dirt bikes, or other off-road vehicles is not allowed.
- Rowdiness, drunkenness and intoxication are absolutely prohibited.
- Do not move to another campsite without permission.
- Campground rental permit holder is responsible for any damages caused to the campground.

Dumping Station

- Do not dump “grey water” such as dishwater on the ground or in any watercourse. Please use the water dumping station provided at the campground.
- Porta-potty waste must not be dumped in campground washrooms. Please use designated wastewater dumping station provided at the campground. Portapotty waste must never be dumped in campground comfort station toilets.

Harrison Park Outdoor Swimming Pool

- Access to the swimming pool is included at no additional cost to registered campground rental permit holders and campers.
- Visitors/Guests of registered campers must pay to use the outdoor swimming pool.
- Swimming pool operating hours are displayed at the campground registration booth.

Park Staff

- City of Owen Sound campground management staff and/or assigned Security Service officers reserve the right to evict anyone from the campground for failure to observe the campground rules and regulations.
- No refund will be provided where a camper is asked to leave for non-compliance with the campground rules in accordance with FPR-002.
